Dear Parents/Carers,

Please note that we have a pedestrian entrance and exit also available for student use on Nutbrook Avenue (the entrance to the old school site). It is much safer to arrange to meet your child there at the end of the school day. Thank you for supporting us in keeping our students safe.
