**Cross Country** This week thirty-three students took part in the Coventry Schools X-Country Championship at Finham Park. We had a successful championship with Finlay and James who came 1st and 2nd in the Y7/8 race and Harriet and Ria who came 6th & 7th in the Year 9 to 11 race on a gruelling course!

The Year 9 & 10 girls team came 2nd overall and the Year 7 boys came 3rd overall. A big thank you to the whole PE staff team for attending.

Year 7 vs Year 8s Football Game - On Tuesday 1st October, in what turned out to be incredibly rainy conditions, a friendly fixture took place between the Y7 and Y8 football teams. It was an excellent end-to-end game with the Y8 team just edging the result with a 4-3 win. The Y7s dominated much of the possession with some fantastically fluid passing plays out from the back, showing their class, remarkable for a team that has never played together before.
