A message from Mrs Neofitou:

We are really looking forward to our school production of Annie next week. Students have been busy rehearsing and I hope to see lots of you there.

Next week we are focussing on student attendance. In tutor time all students will be discussing their current attendance with their tutor. You can see your child's current attendance \% on Go 4 Schools. The government advises that students' attendance should be at least $95 \%$. $95 \%$ equates to 10 missed days, 50 missed lessons! Research has shown that students missing 20 days of school performed a whole grade lower in their exams than similar ability students with good attendance.

Each day in school we continue to remind students about West Coventry's values, our 4 Rs. We talk to our students about being Respectful, Responsible, Resilient and Ready to Learn. Well done to all our students who demonstrate the 4Rs in their lessons, around the school site and also in their community.

Finally, I would like to share some exciting news with you. Our new school building will be ready ahead of schedule! Our fantastic new school building is on track to be completed this summer, ready for students in September. I will be sharing more details with you over the coming weeks, but I know you will share my excitement regarding this news. The new facilities and environment will be transformational for our school community.
