## A message from the Headteacher, Mrs Neofitou:

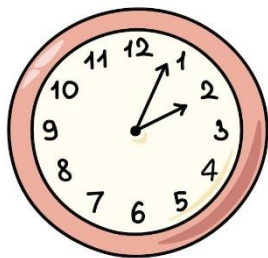
External examinations are well underway, and we are really proud of our students for arriving on time and working hard. We have had 100% attendance for the exams. Well done everyone!

After May half term we will be making some minor changes to the school day in preparation for our move over to the new building. You can read about the changes below.

As part of morning registration each day, tutors will check uniform and equipment to ensure students are Ready to Learn. There will also be a continued focus of punctuality and attendance. Unfortunately, we do still have students arriving late to school in the mornings. Whilst we understand that there are occasions where lateness is unavoidable, all students are expected to have arrived at school by 08:40am each day.

Any student arriving after 08:45am will be considered late to school. We ask for your support in reminding your child of the importance of punctuality and the need to ensure enough time is given to travel to school each morning.

### New School Day Timings
