For Year 12 Students - The Widening Participation & Outreach Team at Warwick University are

offering a wealth of different programmes which would benefit students. The programmes normally run over the 2 years but often attract a lower grade offer for degree courses at Warwick University, the chance to apply for a £2k bursary and for the Warwick Scholars Programme, in some cases, possibly up to 50% discount on tuition fees.

Different Programmes on offer do have an eligibility criteria but if you don't meet it fully, it is still worth applying just in case. These programmes are competitive though and students must commit to the full year but benefit from so much:-

Warwick Scholars - is designed to help you to gain a place at Warwick by maximising your academic potential, developing skills that will help you to succeed here and providing insight and experience of what it will be like to study here.

Realising Opportunities - Realising Opportunities (RO) provides support during post-16 studies to develop the skills to be successful at university.

RO students benefit from increased information, advice and access to some of the country's leading research intensive universities. Students accepted on to RO follow a programme which ensures they are better equipped for university life and what research intensive universities can offer.

Pathways Programme (Law, Engineering and Banking & Finance) -is an engaging two year programme that gives students practical advice about university and the workplace in a particular sector, with the overall aim of leaving students feeling inspired and more confident about their future.

Students interested in a career in Law, Banking & Finance or Engineering will have access to academic lectures, employer engagement, CV and personal statement support in their retrospective stream. The programmes are two years long, starting in year 12 and finishing in year 13.

These programmes are all now open but do have closing dates in October. You can only apply to one of the Programmes so choose what is more beneficial.

Many are within Construction/Engineering but there are many others on offer so please encourage your son/daughter to register to look through and apply for anything of interest-encourage them to widen their search & be open to experience.

NHS Virtual Work Experience Programme commencing on Sunday 2nd October.

Students considering a career in the Allied Health Professions (AHP) are encouraged to secure a place on the programme as soon as possible. This will allow them to complete several sessions of work experience before the UCAS deadline for NHS Health Careers in January. Please note there is a charge for this but if anyone is experiencing financial difficulty, Careers may be able to support this programme.

Once they've registered, students will be emailed links to their virtual work experience portals.

Students are awarded a Work Experience Certificate for every session they complete. Those who complete the full 5 month programme will be awarded a Highly Commended Reference from the Presidents of Allied Healthcare Mentor. These are fantastic additions to their CVs and UCAS applications!

This programme is suitable for students in years 10 - 13 who are interested in the following careers:

- Nursing, Midwifery, Paramedicine, Physiotherapy, Occupational Therapy, Dietetics, Radiography,

Prosthetics and Orthotics, Speech and Language Therapy & Pharmacy

During the work experience day, students will follow 2 patients from their initial presentation to recovery. They will gain a unique insight into how patients interact with a variety of healthcare professionals and what it's like to work in an NHS multidisciplinary team.

Attendees will have the opportunity to interact with healthcare professionals throughout each day. This will empower students to make an informed career decision and demonstrate their commitment to healthcare in their UCAS applications.

Students can register individually at any time throughout the 5-month programme using the link below. We recommend booking early to gain as much out of this programme as possible. Places are £10 a session to cover administrative and technological costs.

There's an initial quiz to help them to start thinking but then students can explore further, looking at what subjects are useful to take, what degree would be useful etc the Higher Ideas link is especially useful for students considering Higher Education and can look geographically what degrees are offered where, looking at 1 subject or a combined subject degree.

For further information, they are offering some Drop in sessions, one during Half Term **Tues 26th October 10am – 2pm and Tues 2nd November 4-7pm.** Students need to be working towards a Grade 5 particularly in Maths and min 5 x Grade 4s including English Language & Science.
