Dear Parent/Carer,

This year NCS are offering a Coventry Half Term programme designed specifically for Year 12 College & Sixth Form students taking into account their interests and areas of study. The NCS programme offers young people a once in a lifetime opportunity to do something meaningful with their autumn break, as well as a chance to develop key skills for employment whilst taking on new challenges that will set them up for adult life. They'll also do something good for their local community, carrying out a project to support a cause they care about. We've seen first-hand what an amazing feeling of accomplishment and increased confidence this brings. Throughout 2021, teenagers on NCS donated 500,000 hours of their time to help rebuild their communities following the pandemic, showing what a difference young people can make when they work together towards a goal.

NCS is all about helping teenagers realise their potential by giving them a taste of independence and loading them up with new skills that set them up to achieve their future goals, whatever they may be. And this is your teens final chance- once they turn 18 they are no longer eligible!

If your teen does want to register their interest in taking part in NCS this autumn, we will ask them to share your contact details. This is so that we can complete the administrative process required to get them signed up to a programme date. If they do let us know they're interested, we'll be in touch with you by email or phone to run through the steps we need to complete their booking.

A place on NCS is worth up to £1200. However, thanks to government funding for the programme, we only ask for a contribution of £50 from you to access the programme. During Phase 2 & 3 of programme, you will be required to bring pack lunch and pay for a bus pass. We want to ensure that everyone can do NCS so there are bursaries available if you need some help to cover the £50 cost.

Bursaries will reduce the cost to £10 for eligible students. Please get in touch with us on  $0116\ 240\ 7007$  to access the bursary amount and discuss bursary criteria.

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## NCS Autumn Dates - Coventry Half Term

Phase 1 - Be Epic - 21<sup>st</sup>, 22<sup>nd</sup>, 23<sup>rd</sup>, 24<sup>th</sup> October. This residential phase begins after college/sixth form on the last Friday of term. It involves 3 nights at an exciting outdoor pursuit centre designed to support leadership and team work skills. Transport will be provided. Pick up/drop off location is the Co-Op on Fairfax Street. Outdoor Activity centre is YHA Haworth, Matlock, Derbyshire.

Phase 2 - Live Life - 25<sup>th</sup>, 26<sup>th</sup>, 27<sup>th</sup> October. The next 3 days see students network with local businesses and get stuck into a business challenge. Students will also participate in workshops that give valuable insights into the world of work. Phase 2 is based at Coventry Methodist Central Hall.

## Phase 3 - Do Good - 28<sup>th</sup> October, 5<sup>th</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup>, 12<sup>th</sup>, 13<sup>th</sup> November.

Students will plan their social action project on the Friday of half term, then complete their project the following weekends. This phase involves students taking action to support local organisations and charities. From fundraisers and social media campaigns to renovations and re-vamp projects, the list is endless! This allows students to make a change in their community and gain volunteering experience. Phase 3 is based at Coventry Methodist Central Hall.

Phase 4 - Go Party - TBC date in November. On completion of the programme students attend a celebration event where they will receive a certificate of recognition signed by the UK prime minister.
