



### WCASF – Dress Code.

- Sixth Form students should dress smartly and appropriately for a working day ‘in the office’, your school is a workplace, and your appearance should reflect that.
- It is important that Sixth Form students should be sensitive to our school community and set a good example to our younger students. Our standards of dress are an important part of the culture in this Sixth Form.
- The aim is for our Sixth Form students to have a smart appearance, which also allows a degree of personal choice.
- BTEC PE/Practical subjects – you wear same as everyone else and if alternative wear is required subjects will communicate this in advance and you will have time to change.
- Lanyards & ID badges are worn at ALL times.
- In cases where there is uncertainty, decisions will be at the discretion of Sixth Form Tutors and Manager.

Tie optional

V-neck or crew neck sweater

Black or brown shoes

Formal jacket, coat



#### Examples for girls:

Straight or tailored trousers

**Knee length** skirt or dress

Blouse or shirt

Jumper or cardigan/waistcoat or jacket

Dark, formal shoes



## What is NOT allowed:

- No trainers/Vans/converse
- No denim
- No joggers/
- No leather items
- No polo or t-shirts
- No mini/short skirts (knee length please)
- No knee length boots
- No shorts (includes girls)
- No hoodies (except worn to/from school)
- No strappy or low tops
